



Welcome to the Df 65 Global Championship 2024 in Nynäshamn

About NSS

Nynäshamns Segelsällskap (Nynäshamns Yacht Club) is one of the larger yacht clubs in Sweden and one of the oldest, with its approximately 1200 members and established in 1915. Over the years we have arranged several regattas, both on national as well as international level, from dinghies like Optimist to yachts like the 12mR. Even 100 ft yachts have competed here at the Big Boat Cup. The most spectacular regatta was the "100 year Olympic Regatta" in 2012.

However, this is the first time we arrange an international regatta for radio controlled boats and we are very delighted to have the opportunity to host the Dragon Force 65 Global Championship at our yacht club, NSS, which is located at the beautiful Strandvägen, and at the breakwater in the harbour of Nynäshamn.

Accommodations

There are two hotels rather near NSS as well as the harbour. The Skärgårdshotellet (means Archipelago Hotel) close to the railway station and the ferry harbour (ferries to Gotland and Poland), 1,8 km from NSS, and the Nynäs Havsbad Hotel och SPA (means Nynäs Sea Bath Hotel and SPA) just across the bay from NSS and 1 km by car or foot.

If you come with a caravan or by mobile home we have the possibility to host your vehicles on our property.

There is a parking lot in front of our old club house, *The Yellow House*.

If you happen to arrive by your own boat you can dock in our guest harbour in the same area. You can also dock in the municipal guest harbour.

How to get to Nynäshamn and to NSS

You can take the commuter train from Stockholm City to Nynäshamn, the end station (there are three stations in the town of Nynäshamn).

From the station you just walk across the street and then 300-400m north and you are at the Skärgårdshotellet. It is just opposite of the ferry harbour.

If you stay at Nynäs Havsbad follow the instructions below but turn left when you come to Oscarsbron, a bridge over to the island Trehörningen. There are signs.

If you go by car you follow route 73 until it ends. Then you just keep on following the road along the coast line, passing the ferry harbour, the railway station, a park and a school. Then you cross the

railway, turn left and follow the shoreline, pass the Hembygdsgården, until you see the NSS area. Google maps may tell you something different, don't trust it. There are signs to point you in the right direction.

By foot you either walk through the park and then follow the same way as the cars, or you follow the pathway that goes between the shore and the railway passing the guest harbour and the yacht harbour, that also belongs to NSS, until you reach the bridge over the railway and then turn left and follow the same route as the cars.

Registration, measuring and opening ceremony.

When you have been registered, paid your lunches, extra regatta dinners and received your goodie bag you will get a slot time when to measure your boat. Bring all sails, rigs, the boat and the batteries you intend to use during the regatta.

The registration will be at our new club house, in the office, *The Grey House*, located at the shore.

The measuring of the boats will take place in the same house, in the large room. All sails, rigs, parts of the boat and the batteries will be measured. Make sure you have the plastic hatch on the boat, that the on/off button is present, that all numbers in the sails are clear and filled in completely. Random checks will take place during the week.

Regatta dinner is included for all competitors, officials and specially invited guests. Tickets for other attendees can be purchased at registration to a cost of 550 Skr. Includes main course, dessert, coffee and a glass of wine or a beer.

The opening ceremony is scheduled for Saturday 11/5 at 16.00. You'll get some sparkling wine and snacks. There will be speakers from different organisations and the municipal council of Nynäshamn. The Sailors Pub will be open from 12.00.

Tune Up and Show Up

Tune Up sailings will take place at the breakwater in the commercial harbour between 12.00 and 15.00 on Saturday 11/5.

Show Up/Tune Up sailings at the Yacht Club between 12.00 and 15.00 on Saturday 11/5.

Of course everyone is welcome to sail any time they prefer at the Yacht Club jetty or at the breakwater.

Facilities at the Yacht Club

In the *The Grey House* there are toilets, showers and a sauna located in a separate part of the building. The sauna and showers will be possible to use even if the races are in the commercial harbour, near the railway station. Just let me know.

On the north side of the building, on the harbour plane, is our very, very local pub, the Sailors Pub, located. It will be open on the two first days of the event. Here is also where we will have the opening ceremony, on Saturday afternoon at 16.00.

In the yellow house there is a club café open on Saturday and Sunday 8.30 – 15.00.

Racing Area

The racing area has been relocated from NSS in Fagerviken to the commercial harbour, situated just south of the ferry terminal and north of the Sea Rescue Station, at the end of the 380 m long breakwater.

The race office will be located on the jetty at a Nauticat 38. This is also where the Notice Board will be.

For your convenience the old passenger ship Flora will be stationed on the inside of the breakwater. On Flora there will be lunch available for those who have bought lunch tickets and for functionairs. Coffee and tea will be served to all competitors and functionairs. Softdrinks will be sold on board.

Flora has got one toilet. Additional toilets can be found at the railway station (costing 10 Skr, payable with card) about 300m from the mount of the jetty and at the guest harbour around 600m from the mount of the jetty.

Lunch

Lunch tickets can be purchased at the registration. A lunch kit includes a lunch sandwich and a yougurt or something similar, costing 70 Skr, payable with card.

Coffee and tea is included for all competitors and functionairs. Soft drinks can be purchased onboard. Plain drinking water is available from the taps on the jetty.

Socials

Since the race area has been moved from NSS to the breakwater in the commercial harbour near the railway station and the ferry terminal, we can't offer any ”After Sail” after the races, but there is a very nice local pub, The Eight Friends Inn, in the old railway station house, that I can recommend. There are also some good restaurants in the harbour area.

For those not competing and don't want to stay in the race area there is a beautiful walk passing the NSS area and following the shore southwards. It is possible to go by car, but it is not recommended.

The city center is just a 5 minute walk up the Kyrbacken (Church Hill) where you find the chocolaterie, Chokladhuset, Mullers konditori (a bakery and café), grocery stores and other shops. The local brewery, Nynäshamns Ångbryggeri is also located in the city center.

In the Guest Harbour you will find the Turist Information and some very nice restaurants, for example Rökeriet, Kroken and Skärgårdscaféet.
